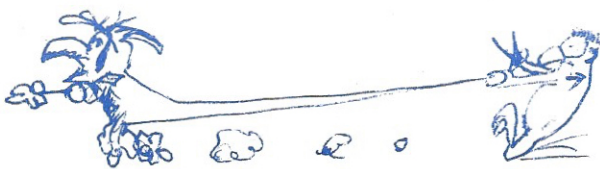

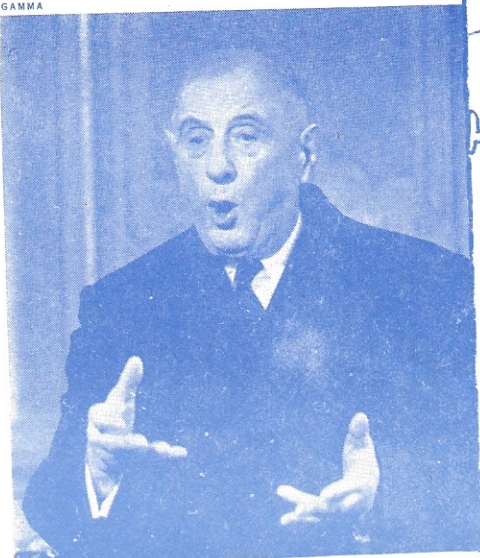

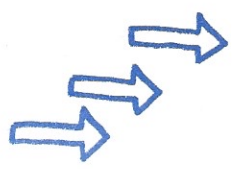

A Revolutionary Appeal Finds Little Support

MIAMI (AP) — Only one person out of 50 approached on Miami streets by a reporter agreed to sign a typed copy of the Declaration of Independence.

Two called it "Commie junk," one threatened to call the police and another warned Miami Herald reporter Colin Dangaard: "Be careful who you stow that kind of anti-government stuff to, buddy."

A questionnaire, circulated among 300 young adults attending a Youth for Christ gathering showed that 28 percent though an excerpt from the Declaration was written by Lenin.

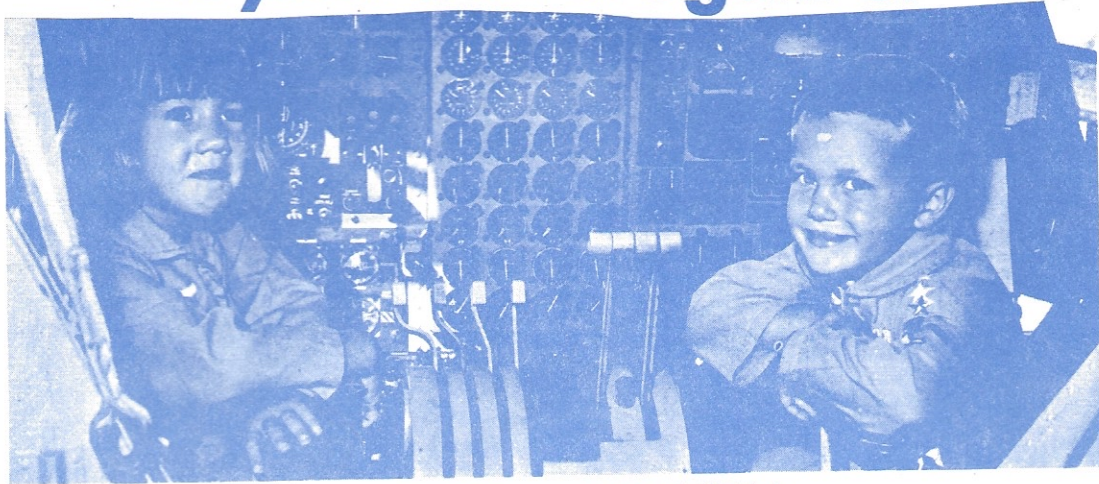

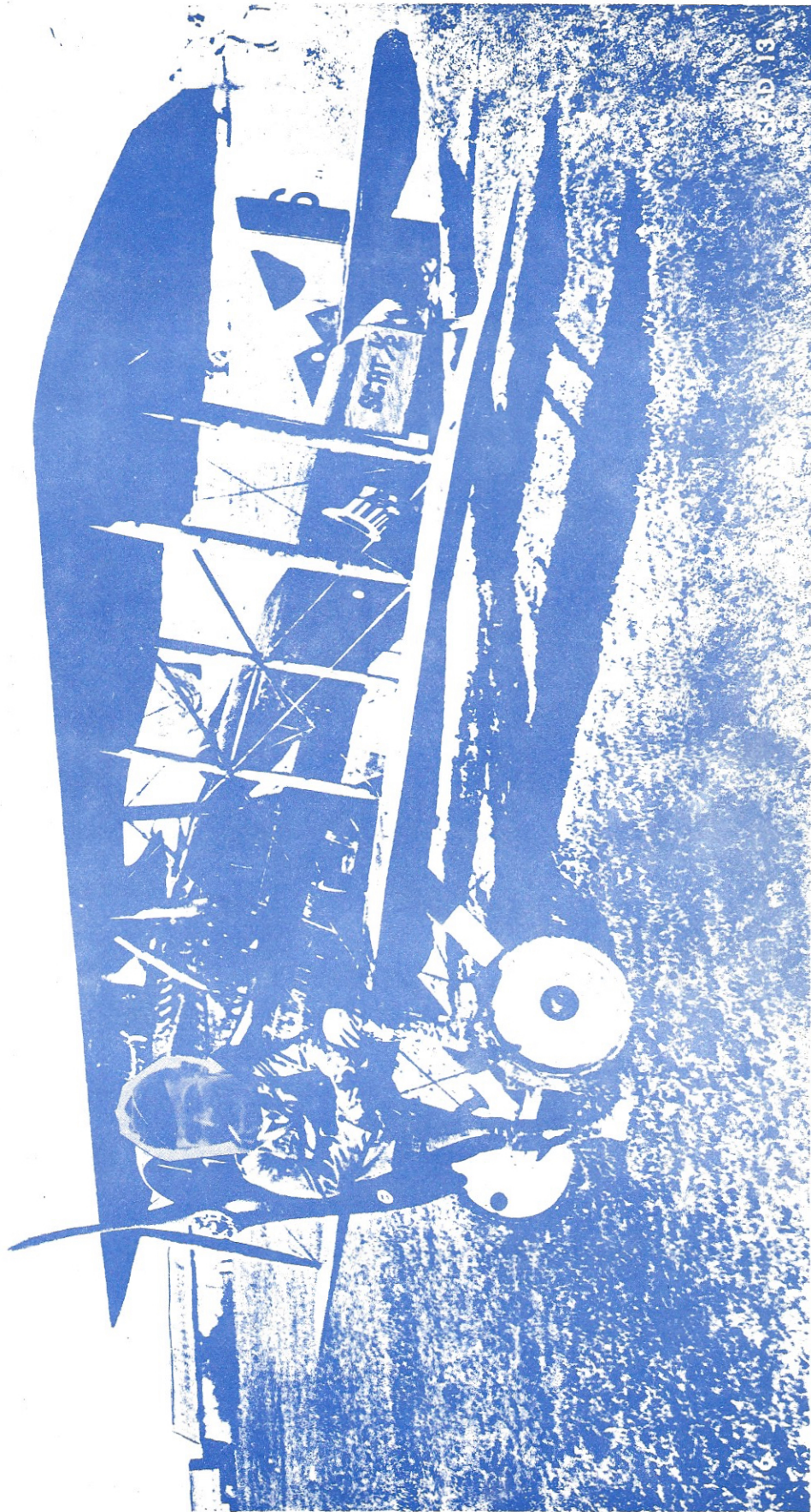
