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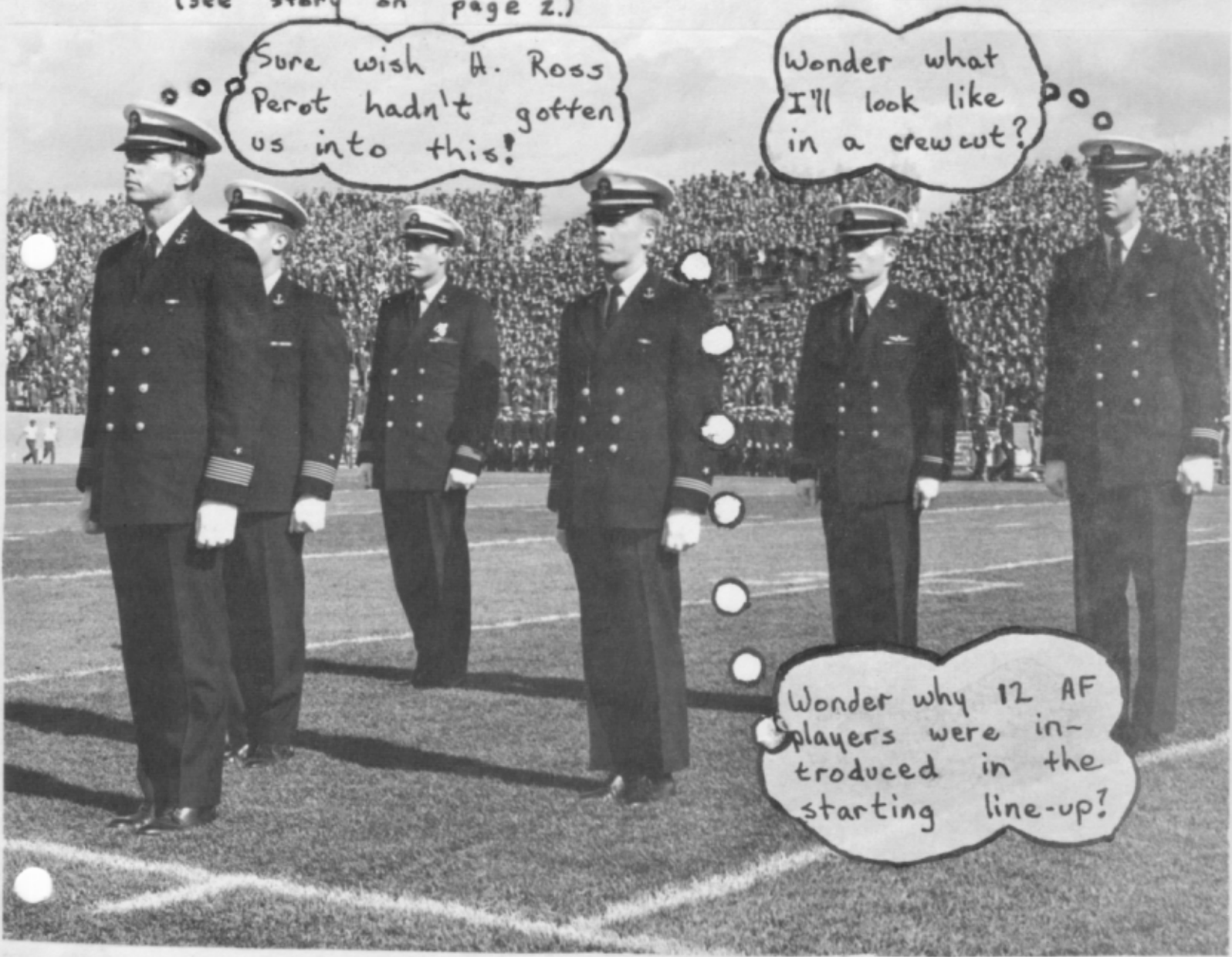

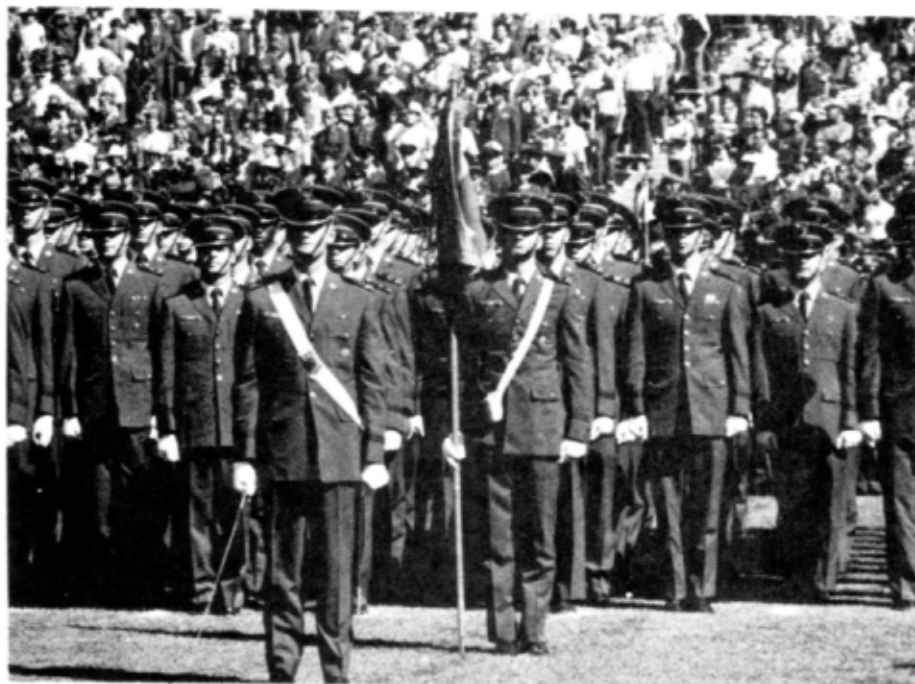

The AF Cadet Wing, led by its seasoned commander, Bentley Rayburn, literally marched the USNA Midshipmen off the field in the annual AFA-USNA March-On last Saturday at USAFA. A capacity crowd of over 50,000 watched the Cadet Wing whip the Middies soundly for the second straight year.

The Falcons dominated drill from the first "Forward March" to the last "Squadron Halt." Stymied and frustrated by a tough AFA Element Leader rank, the Middies were unable to step off on the left foot for the entire afternoon. Perhaps the most outstanding performance of the day was put in by the A Flight Guide. Only a sophomore who played little as a freshman last year, Cadet Third Class Bill Pressansmoke gained a starting berth this season and performed two right turn marches, a guide on-line and post without a flaw.

Although Navy did mount a strong Present Arms during the National Anthem, they were unable to overcome the mighty About Face and Double Time March of the AF Cadets. The Cadets led at USAFA Pre-Game by a wide margin.

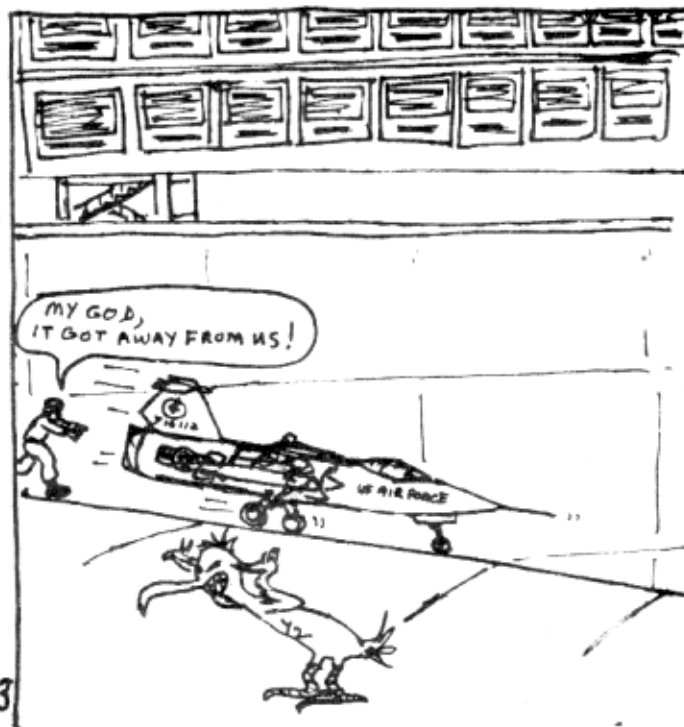
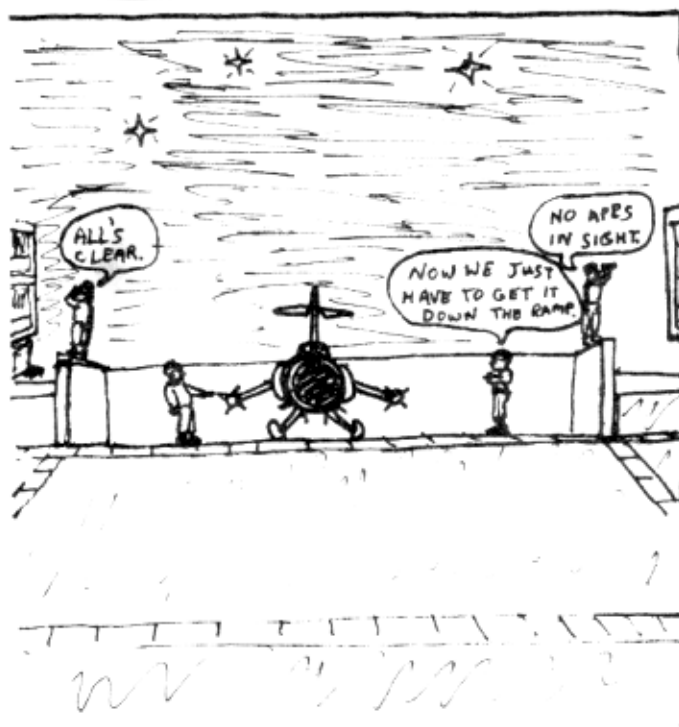
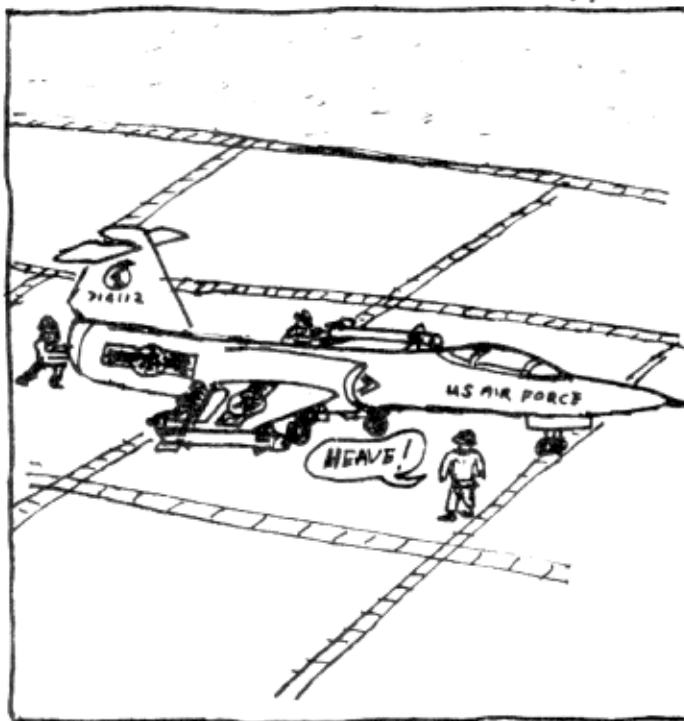
