


## AFA to cut strength by half

of Accounting and Finance at the US Air Force Academy received word recently from the Office of Management and Budget in Washington that the administrative costs of operating 40 squadrons of cadets have become so high that the Academy will have to reduce the number of cadet squadrons by half. 
- 1. Cadets are no longer permitted to abuse the peanut butter.
