


EDITÒKIAL








"LIVE AT THE FIELDHOUSE" by Johnny Parka and the Accessories

Borderline Band will be with us for at least another semester.


"TEN AND THREE" by Heavy D and the Restrictions

Fact: In 1874 Mr. Osgood Finsterwald was electrecuted while trying to pop popcorn in an electric popper while taking a bath.


The inherent danger of popcorn is obvious. So that cadets will not be injured through similar experiences in their rooms, popcorn poppers have been forbidden from cadet rooms.
