



THE EVOLUTION OF A SHOESHINE




4° Year: Extensive use of cotton balls, water, fire, cloth, and work!



2º Year: Use of socks to touch up' shoes while getting dressed.




3° Year: Heavy reliance on brushes; still may use some polish.



1°Year: May occasionally wipe shoes on calf of pants before formations.














