-- Iron some good "hospital" corners on the sheets of your bed at least once a month.

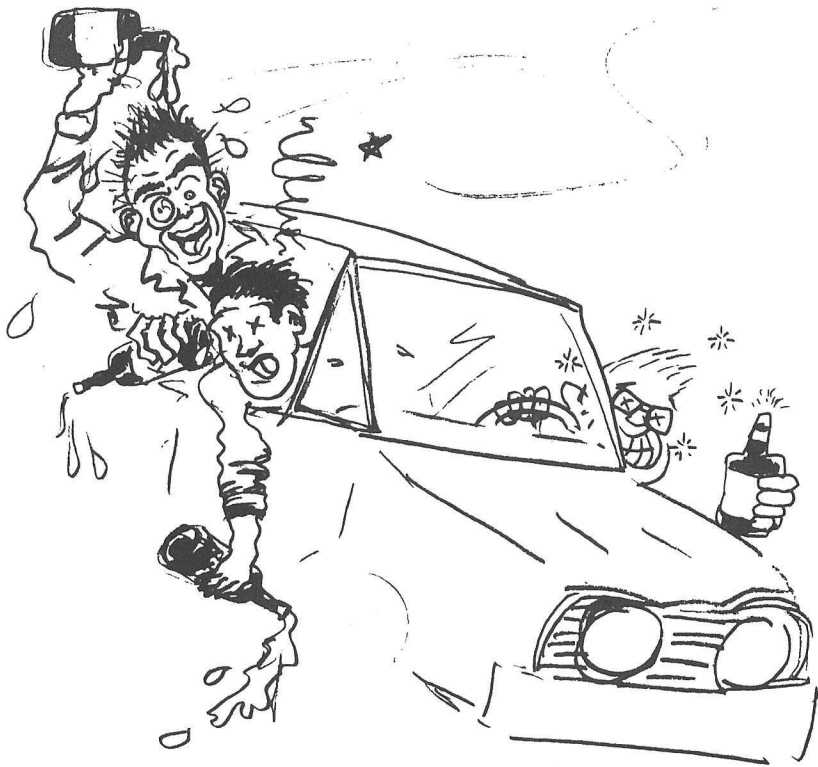
-- Have your kid march with an M-1 for an hour if he screws up.

 Good riddance.

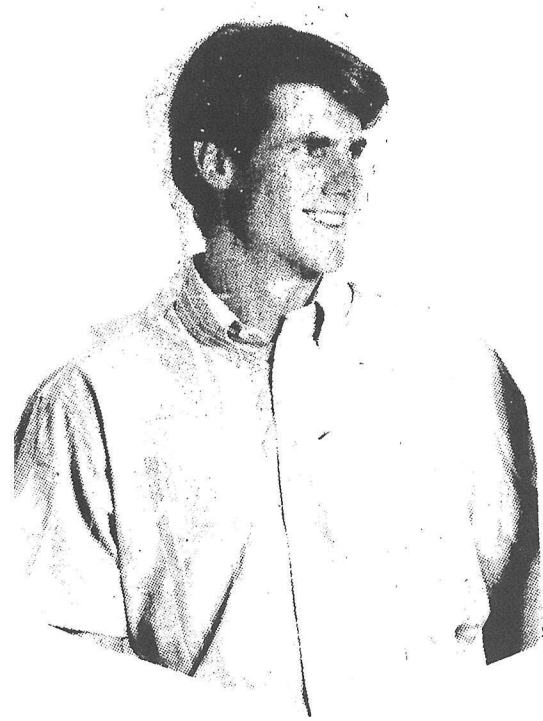
