# DUKAKIS JOINS STUDENTS IN ANTI-CADET CAMPAIGN



Gov. Michael Dukakis yesterday questioned the "morality" of Air Force Academy cadets, lambasting cadet behavior in and around the Colorado Springs area.

Gov. Dukakis is shown above holding a rap session with members of Project Cadet, a local organization of college students opposed to cadets. Several members of the organization voiced outrage at what they term "typical cadet behavior."
