WRIGHT-PATTERSON AFB (AFNS) - The Air Force Logistics Command has recently sent out requests for proposals for the Advanced Next Generation General Purpose Mechanical Pencil (ANGGPMP). It will replace the currently-used Skilcraft Mk. 20A "Hermes" Mechanical Pencil, which is scheduled to be phased out of the Air Force inventory by 1992. The ANGGPMP will integrate current technology and state-of-the-art design concepts that will make it much more effective than the Mk. 20A. Design specifications call for lead graphite that is refillable, as well as replaceable eraser modules. While the Mk. 20A did not have these features and had to be discarded after use, the ANGGPMP should prove to be cost-effective. Other specifications call for its operability in high-altitude, low-pressure environments as well as in -60° F Arctic to 120° F tropic conditions. It must withstand tensile stresses of 700psi and shear stresses of up to 300psi, or better, without overheating. Contenders for the ANGGPMP R&D contract and a future write-off competition are Skilcraft Aerospace, BiC Data Systems, Pentel Electronics, and Northrop. Prototype rollout data is slated to be in June with IOC expected at Grand Forks AFB, ND, in December 1990. Tenative production plans call for 1 million models at \$1.33 million. The U.S. Navy is considering a joint-service venture proposal by AFLC (the Navy is currently in the feasibility studies phase for its Advanced Mechanical Lead Writing Device [AMLWD]). Navy designs call for augmented seawater corrosion resistance.



Admiral Scuttles Naval Academy's Playmid'

Midshipmen Ordered to Destroy 5,000 Copies of 'Inappropriate' Satire Magazine

ANNAPOLIS, April 12-The superintendent of the U.S. Naval Academy has barred distribution of a satirical student magazine leaturing a centerfold photograph of a woman midshipman lounging in a swimsuit because the publication could be offensive to some students, academy officials said today.

The 5,000 copies of the April edition of the student magazine, which was designed as a parody of Playboy, were ordered destroyed by the superintendent, Rear Adm. Virgil L. Hill.

Although the magazine, The Log, contained no nude photographs or sexually explicit articles. Hill ordered the ban because he "felt the concept of the magazine was inappropriate," said Cmdr. Stephen Becker, a Naval Academy spokes-

The order to ban the publication comes amid growing Navy concern over the sensitivities of women midshipmen, who make up 10 percent of the brigade of midshipmen at the Naval Academy.

The student editors and the faculty adviser of the magazine have been "counseled" as a result of the publication, but have not been given formal reprimands or punishment, Becker said.

Students assembled for lunch today in the academy's massive dining hall were atrongly urged to return 420 copies of the magazine that were unaccounted for after the ban on distribution was announced.

Some midshipmen said they believed Hill's decision was a form of censorship.

"We're here training to uphold democratic principles, yet we aren't even allowed to see the magazine before this decision is made," said one male midshipman.

But other midshipmen and faculty members, who have complained previously about biting satire or smaller pictures of scantily clad women published frequently in the magazine, supported the deci-

Some students and faculty members said that the magazine, which contains sharp academy-oriented humor, has drawn lire from some blacks and women for past satires, cartoons and photographs.

Becker said ,editors recently

apologized for a photograph of a black midshipman carrying a stereo record player out of a room in Bancroft Hall, in connection with recent reports of thefts in the midshipmen's iving quarters.

The April edition, dubbed "Playmid," contained a drawing of a woman in a military camouflage bikini on the cover and a photograph of a woman midshipman wearing a "conservative" onepiece bathing sult in the centerfold, Becker said. It also included photographs of bare-chested male pin-ups, he said.

The male models were not midshipmen, Becker said.

The articles in Playmid included examples of the satire poking fun at the strict discipline and academy life styles found in most editions of

the magazine, Becker said.

The magazine also included a regular feature called "Campus Cuties, a collection of photographs of girlfriends and boyfriends of midshipmen.

One recent edition contained several suggestive photos in the "Campus Cuties" section, including one woman in a bikini bathing suit leaning over a rumpled bed with the caption, "Open invitation" under the

The "Campus Cuties" section also includesd photographs of men, including one recently standing in a shower with a towel draped over his outstretched arms.

The cartoon bore the caption, "Drop . . . Towel."


Becker said midshipmen give the magazine the photographs of their boytriends or girlfriends for use in the section.

While much of the magazine's

operation is funded by subscription fees, the academy also provides funds for the sanctioned extracurricular activity.

Articles, cartoons and stories are contributed by midshipmen.
