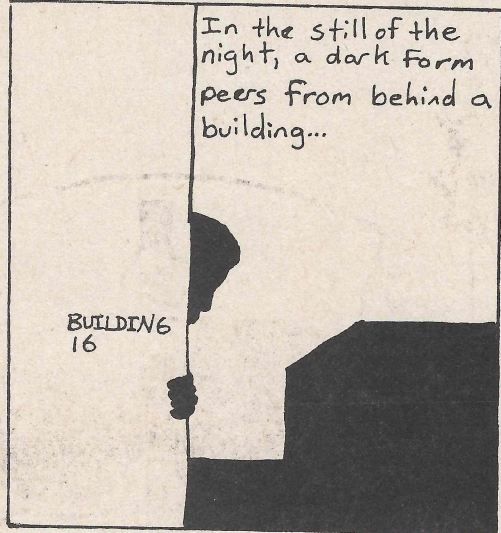
STRACT WARS
