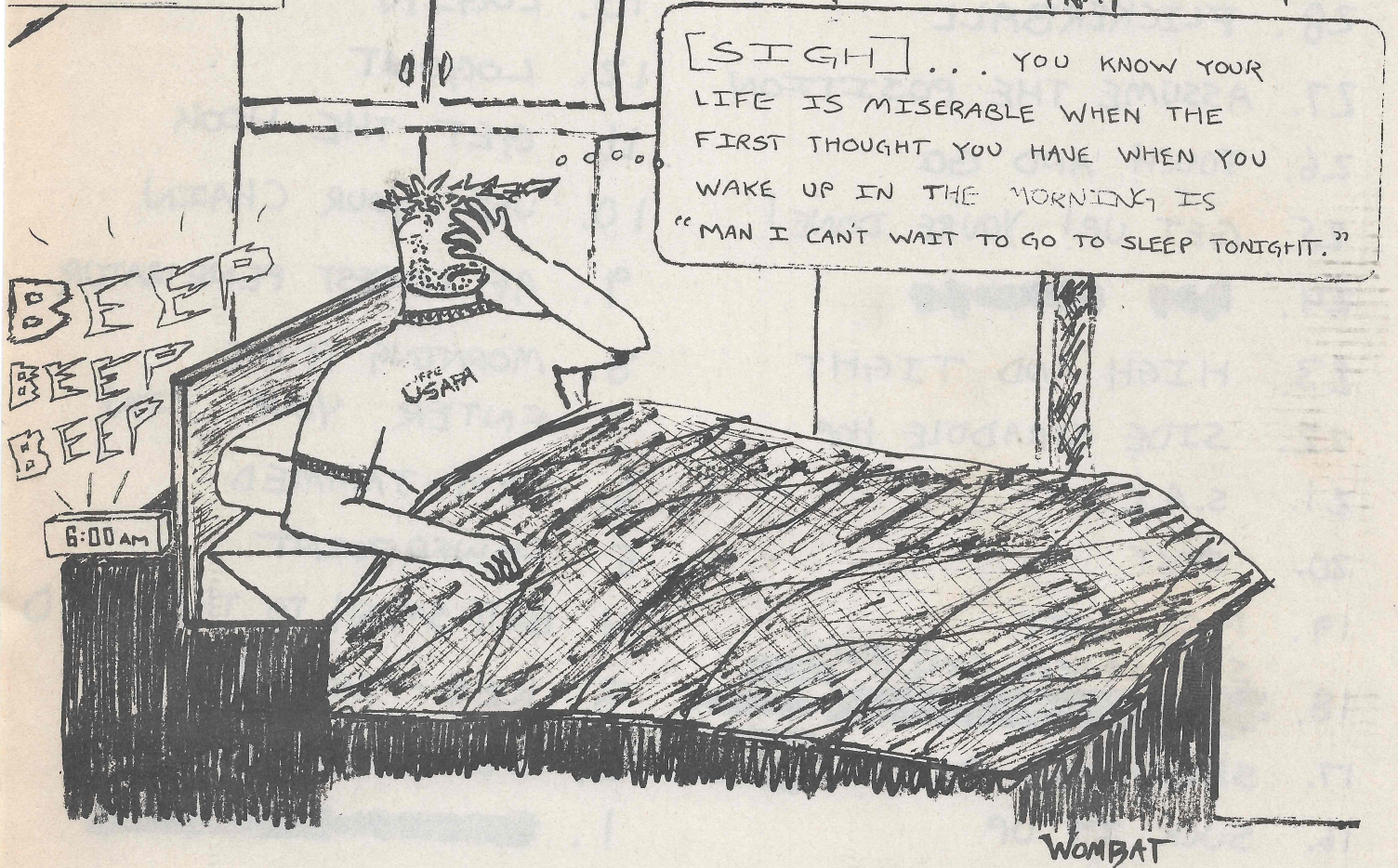

1. In a brief essay of not more than ten minutes compare and contrast the ideas of Jomini and Clausewitz.

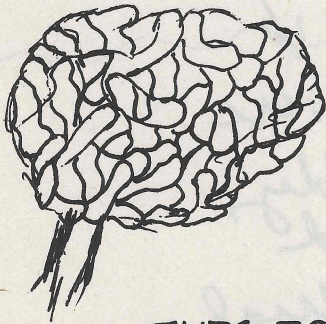

Before this time the U.S. was not established and had to be protected by Britain. When the Mexicans became a threat to the young expanding nation, the U.S. decided to "carpe diem" and take the territory from the Mexicans.
