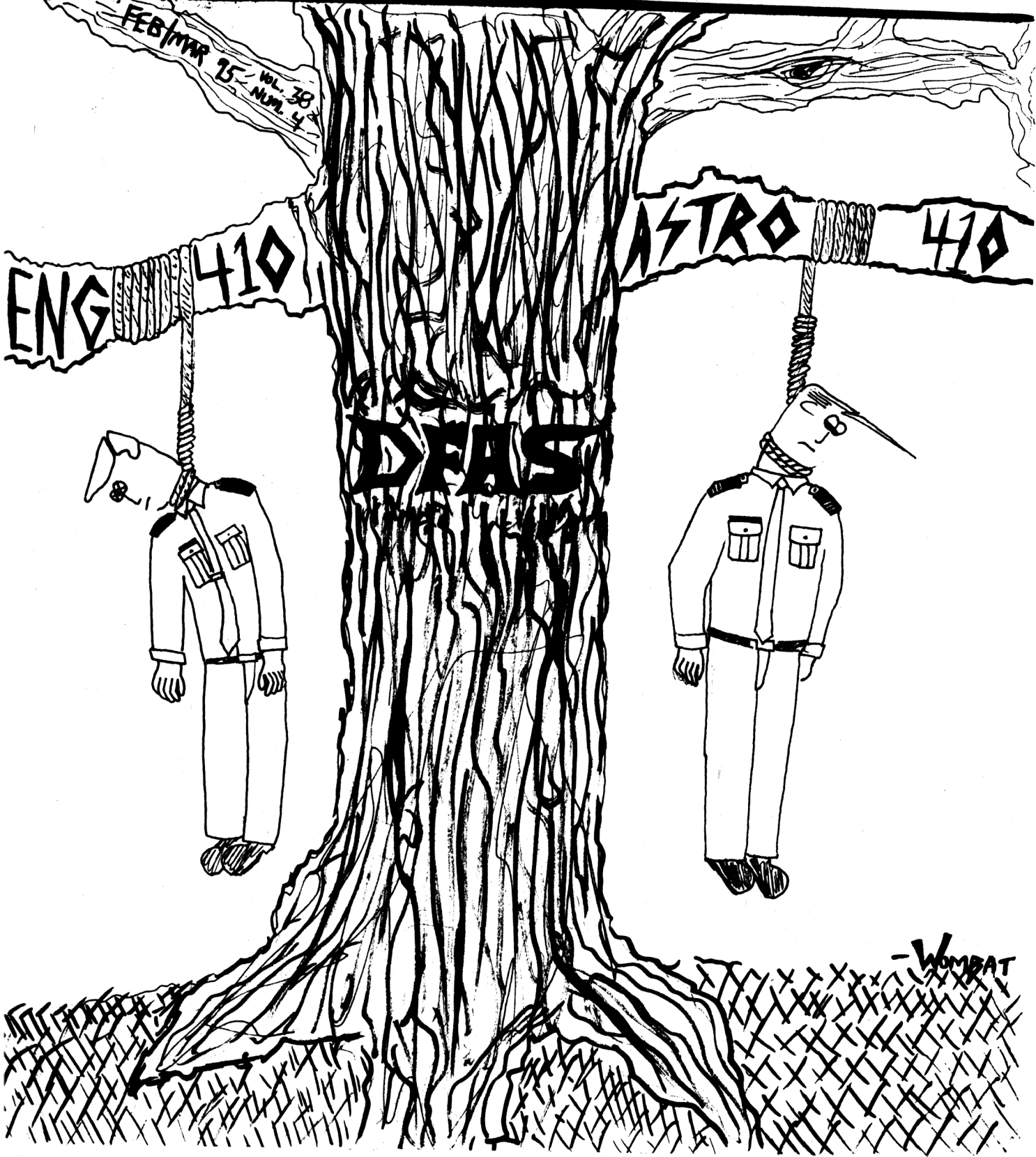
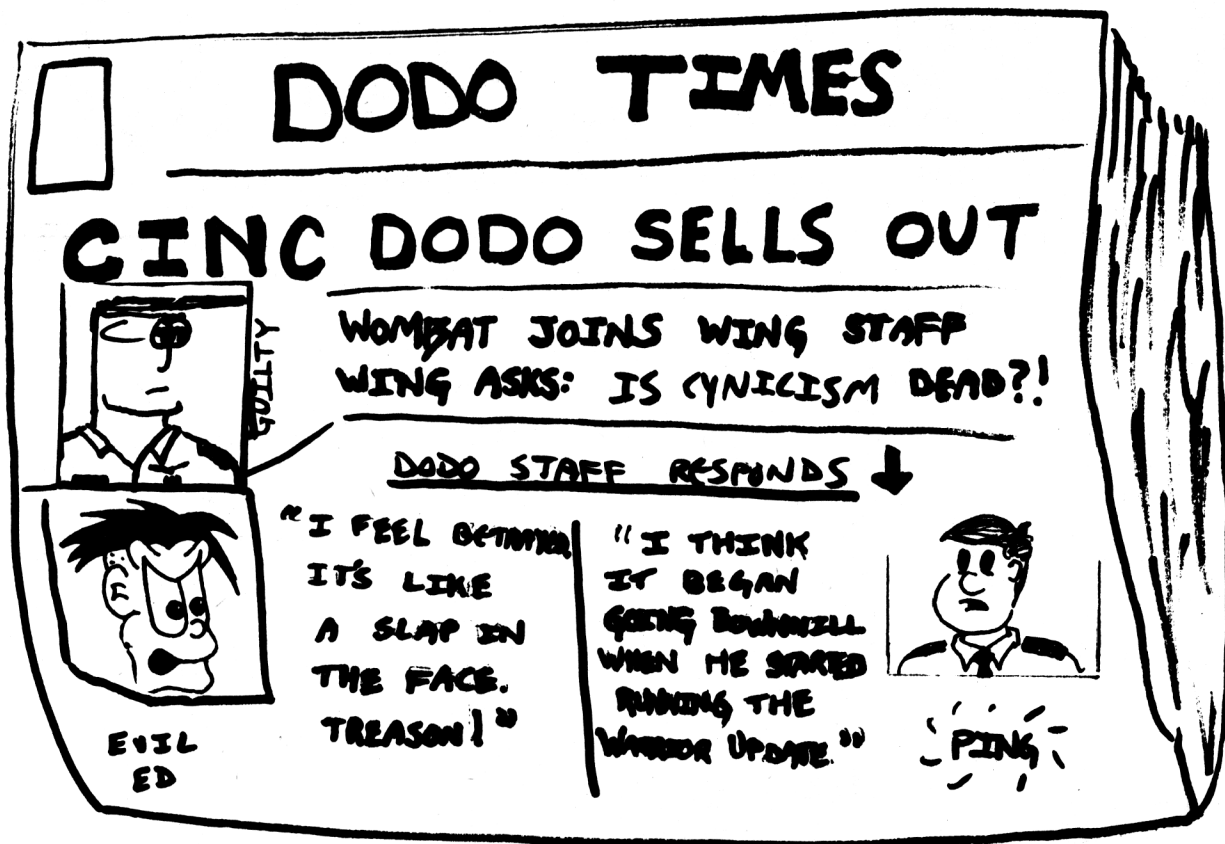


THE DODO
