We will have it out in just a second, Sir.



can appreciate.....




If that's the way you guys play I'm taking my marbles and going home.....



Shining defensive play in the Air Force secondary and the quick thinking of Falcon halfback Parma salvaged the victory for the Cadets.

Three key Bearcat passes were snagged by alert Falcon defenders, the last by the Falcon standout Terry I saacson crushing a last desperate CU thrust deep in Falcon territory with less than two minutes to play. Bearcat passing efforts were futher hindered by fast charging Falcon linemen Fenske and Sicks.


