MISSING LINK FOUND!

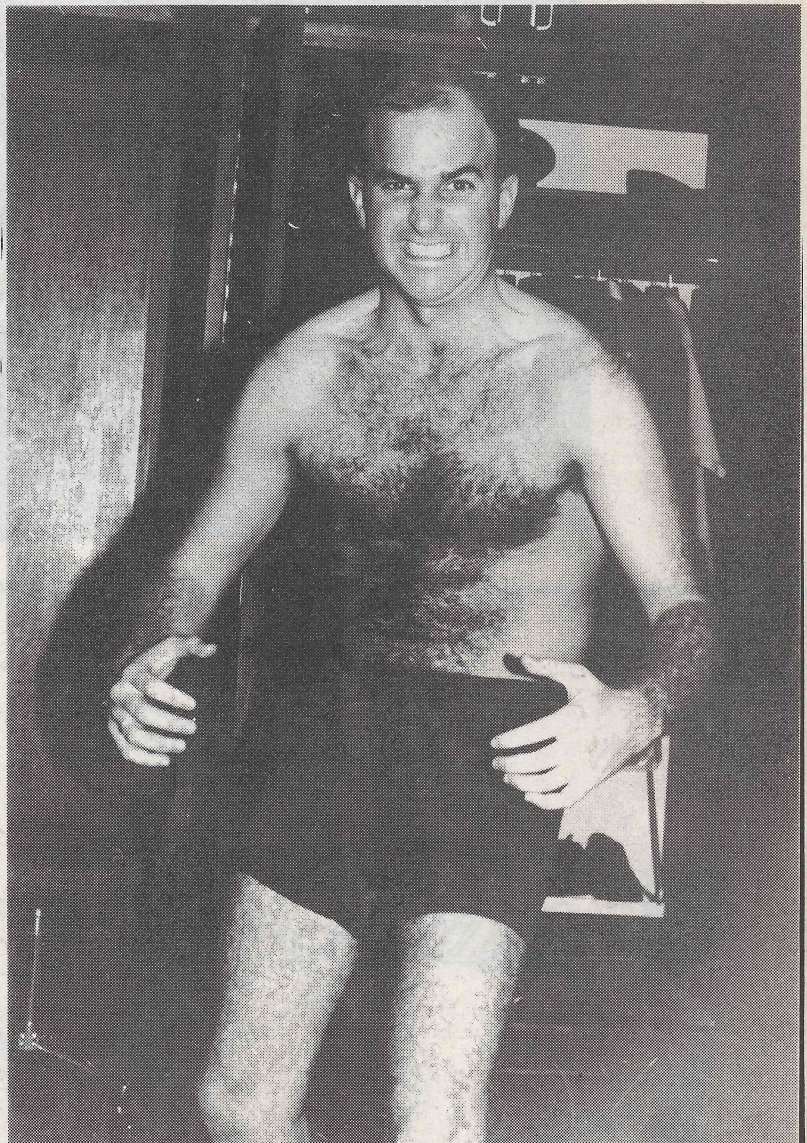

The general public has been asked not to interact too closely with the Sweezy-creature for the time being, while Academy officials review its academic and military record. This process is expected to take a minimum of four months.

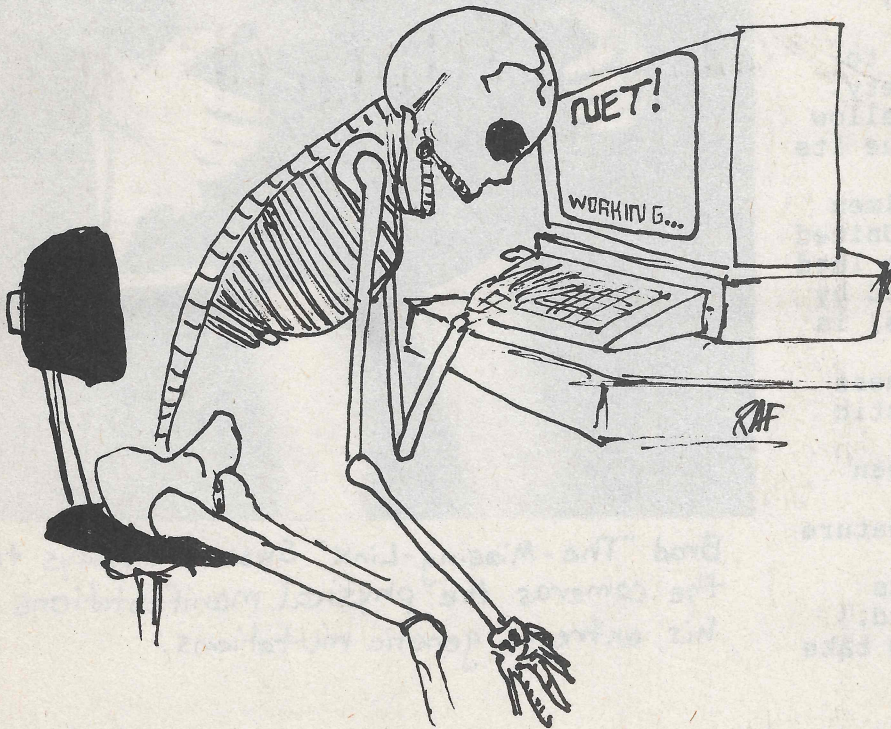


Brad "The-Missing-Link" Sweezy displays to the cameras the physical manifestations of his extreme genetic mutations.
