UPT QUALIFICATION EXAMINATION

Instructions: Read each question carefully. Answer all questions. Time limit is one hour.

1. **HISTORY:** Describe the history of the papacy from its origin to the present day, concentrating especially, but not exclusively on its social, political, economic, religious, and philosophical impact on Europe, Asia, America (North and South), and Africa. Be concise and specific.
2. **MEDICINE:** You have been provided with a razor blade, a piece of gauze, and a bottle of Scotch. Remove your appendix. Do not suture until your work has been inspected. You have 15 minutes for this part of the examination.
3. **PUBLIC SPEAKING:** 2,500 riot-crazy Aborigines are storming the classroom. Calm them. Use any ancient language except Greek or Latin.
4. **BIOLOGY:** Create life. Estimate the effect on the co-existing human culture if this form of life had been developed 500 million years earlier, with special attention to its probable effect on the English Parliamentary system. Prove your thesis.
5. **MUSIC:** Write a piano concerto. Orchestrate and perform it with a flute and a drum. You will find a piano under your seat.
6. **PSYCHOLOGY:** Based on your knowledge of their works, evaluate the emotional stability, degree of adjustment, and repressed frustrations of each of the following: Alexander of Aphrodisias, Rameses II, Gregory of Nicaea, and Hammurabi. Support your evaluation with a quotation from each man's work, making appropriate references. It is not necessary to translate.
7. **SOCIOLOGY:** Estimate the sociological problems which might accompany the end of the world. Construct an experiment to test your theory.
8. **ENGINEERING:** The disassembled parts of a high-powered rifle have been placed on your desk. You will also find an instruction manual printed in Swahili. In 10 minutes a hungry Bengal Tiger will be admitted to the room. Take whatever action you feel appropriate. Be prepared to justify your decision.
9. **ECONOMICS:** Develop a realistic plan for refinancing the National debt. Trace the possible effects of your plan in the following areas: Cubism, the Donatist controversy, and the Wave theory. Outline a method for preventing these effects. Criticize this method from all possible points of view, and point out any deficiencies of your points of view, as demonstrated in your answer to the last question.
10. **POLITICAL SCIENCE:** There is a red phone on the desk beside you. Start World War III. Report at length on its socio-political effects, if any.
11. **EPISTEMOLOGY:** Take a position for or against truth. Prove the validity of your stand.
12. **PHYSICS:** Explain the nature of matter. Include in your answer the evaluation of the impact of the development of mathematics on science.
13. **PHILOSOPHY:** Sketch the development of human thought, estimating its significance. Compare it with the development of any other kind of thought.
14. **GENERAL KNOWLEDGE:** Contrast human life-style in the year 2,000 B.C. with predictions of human life-style in the year 4,000 A.D. Describe in detail. Be both objective and specific.
15. **THEOLOGY:** Assume Catholicism had originated in Hawaii; Methodism in Bolivia; and Buddhism in Salt Lake City. Estimate the impact this would have had on: a) polygamy, b) idolatry, and c) separation of church and state. Concentrate on the socio-economic and political aspect.
16. **ASTROLOGY:** Describe the universe. Give three (3) examples.

If you complete the examination prior to the allotted time, use the remaining time to recheck your paper.

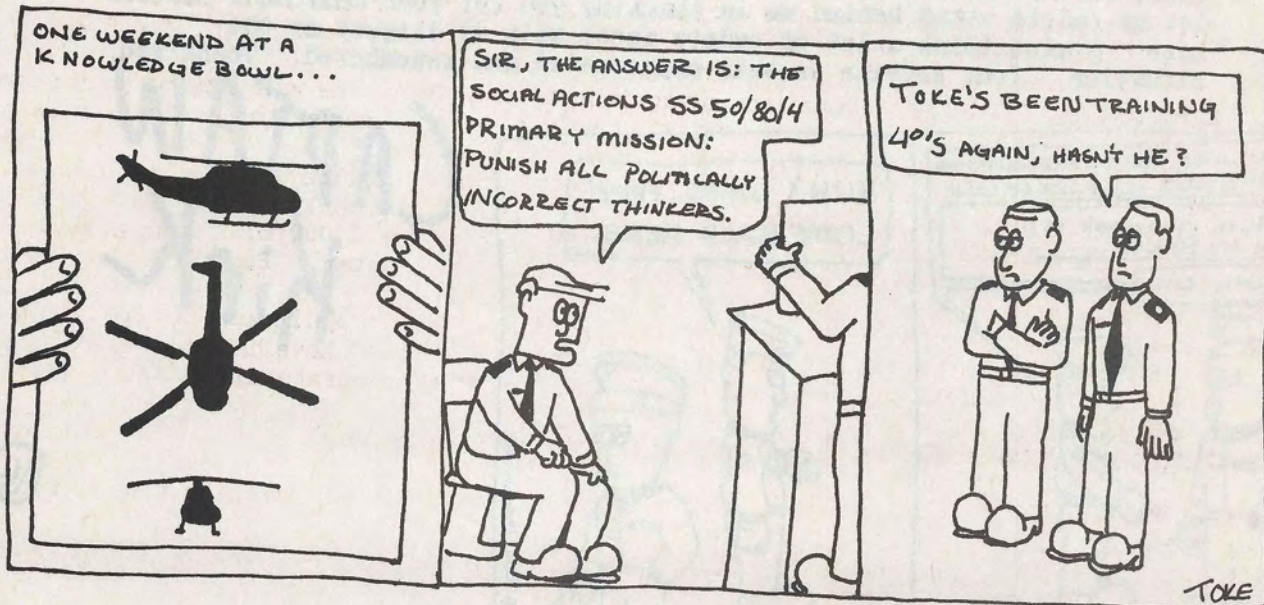

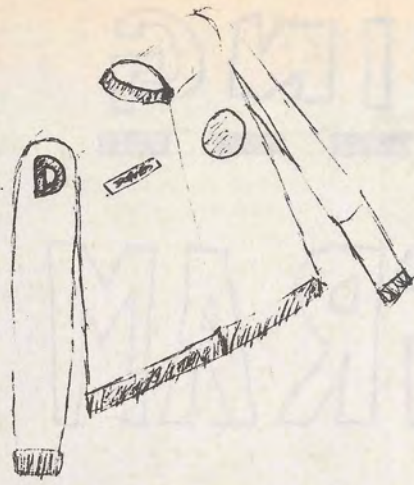
I'm mad, folks. Cadets have very few people who spend 100% of their time trying to assist cadets rather than pimping them!

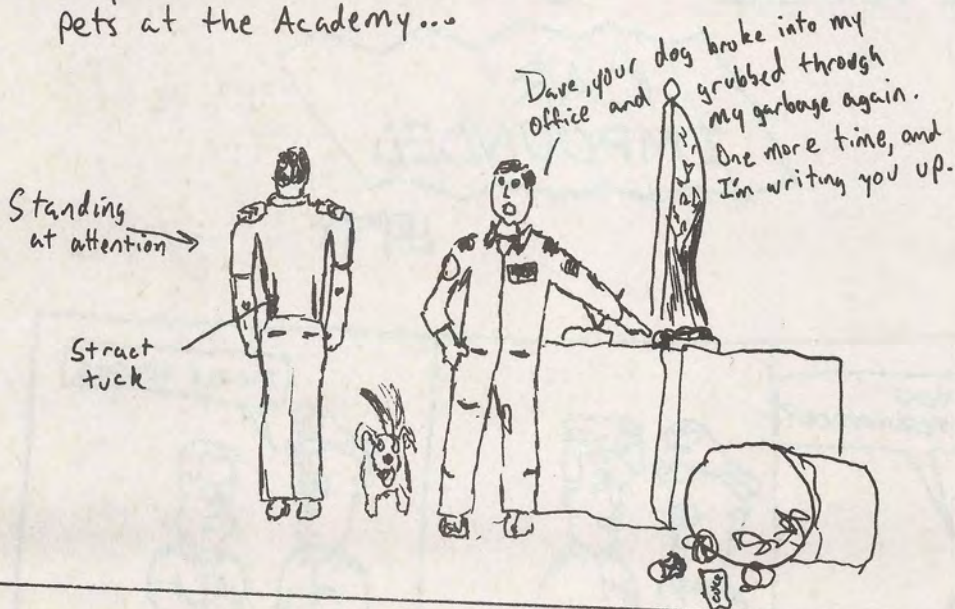

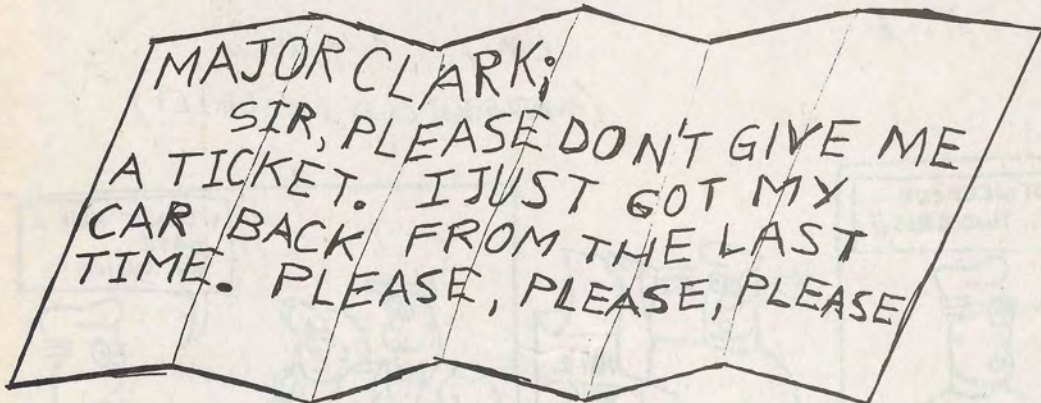

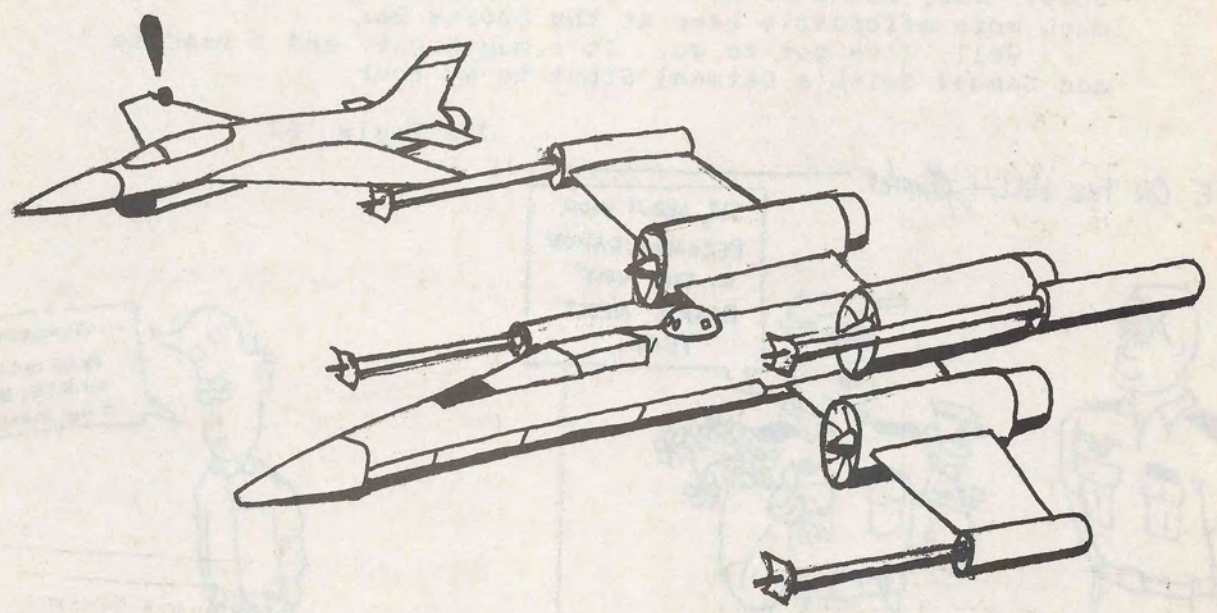

PEOPLE WITH FAR TOO MUCH

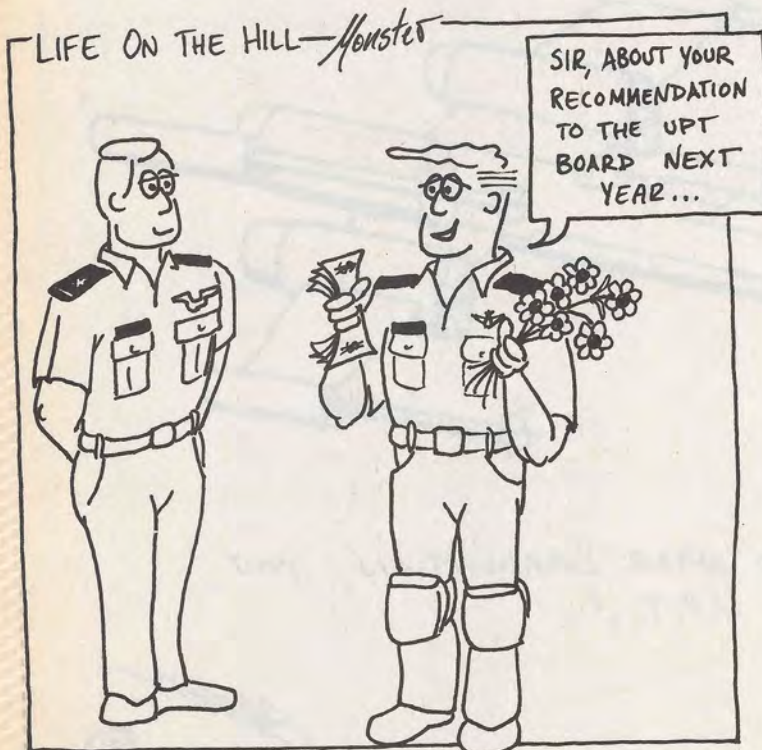

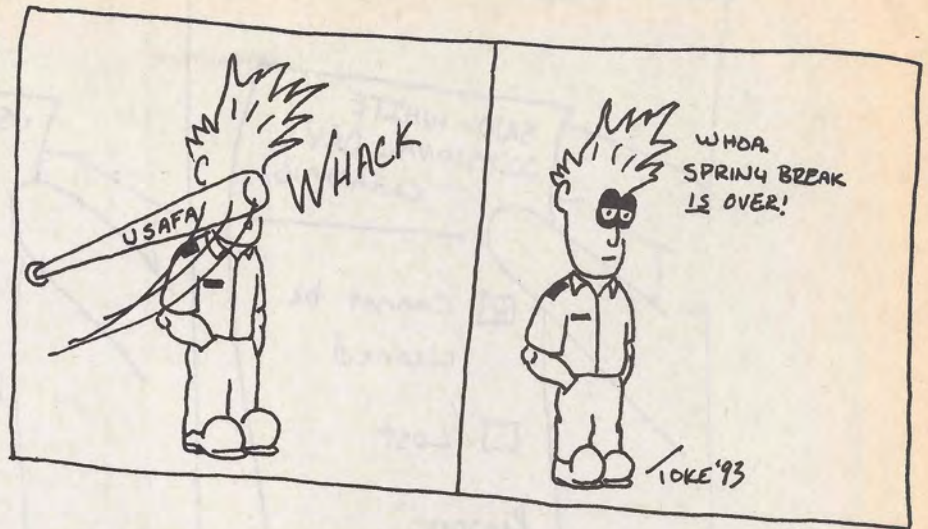

insane.

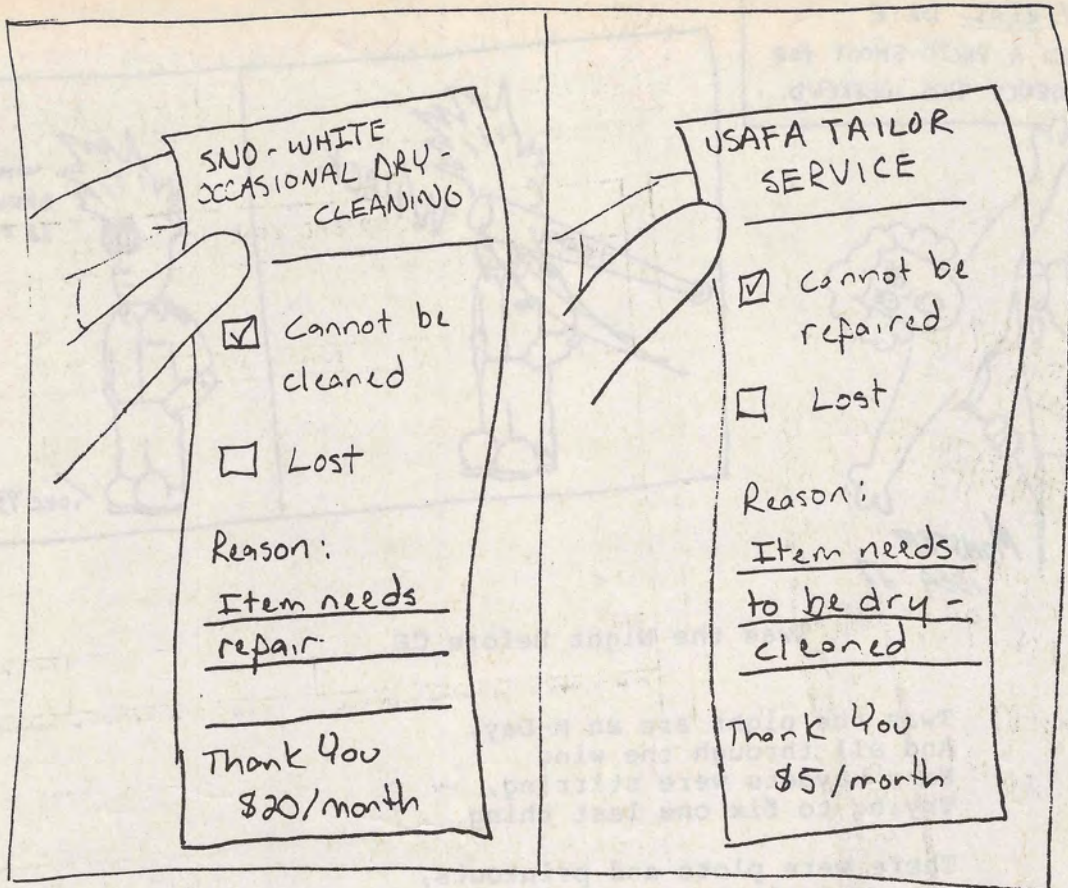
The time that they took, the hours they consumed.

I mean, hey, is some fictional Muppet going to kick my ~~ass~~?

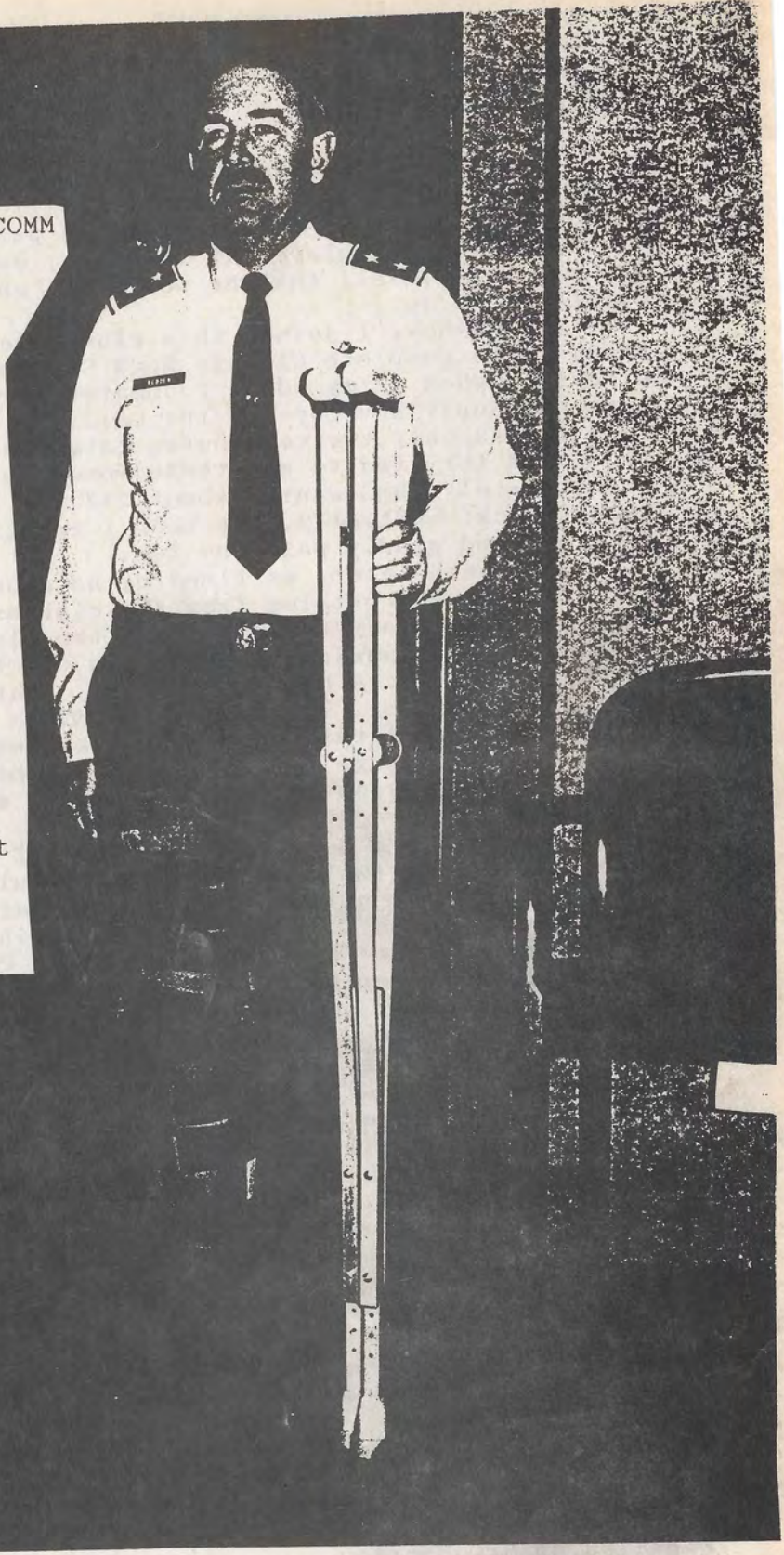
