In a medical occupation.

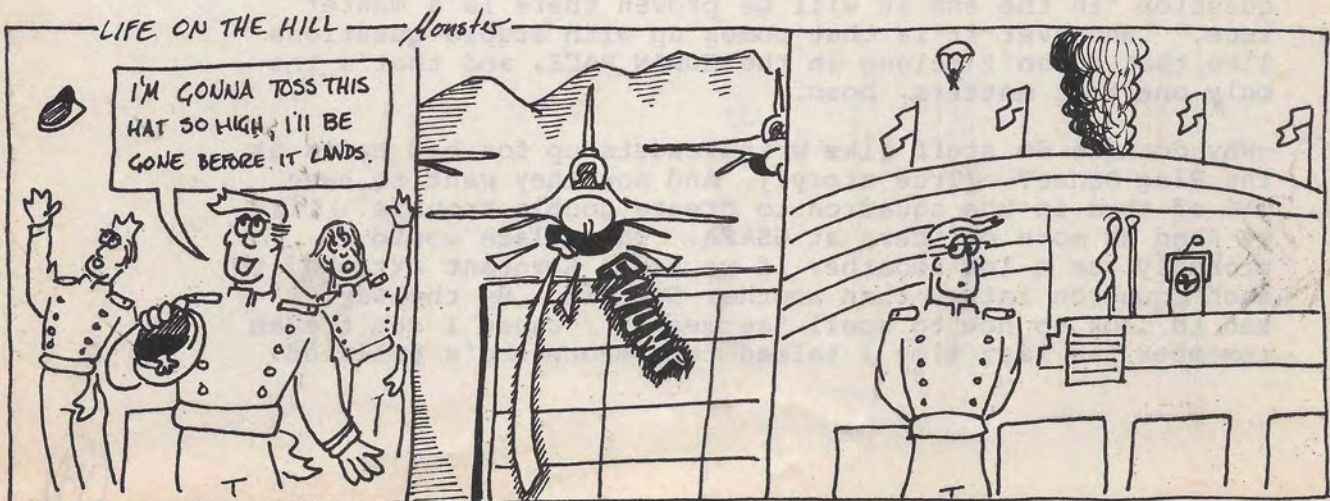
My only hesitation

In the annals of rock 'n' roll, Yoko Ono is generally dressed in black and receives the same kind of character references as Ma Barker, Lucrezia Borgia and Alexis Carrington.

History has painted Ono as an illicit influence who broke up the Beatles and led the late John Lennon astray. Her music has suffered attacks harsher than anything this side of vintage Donny Osmond.

So she seems like a perfect candidate to release a special six-CD career retrospective such as "Onobox" (Rykodisc), which hit record stores last week.

"I still can't get over it," Ono, 59, says of the six-hour, 105-song set. It covers her career from 1969 to '92 and includes an entire album, "A Story," that has never been released. "In 1989, some company came to me and said

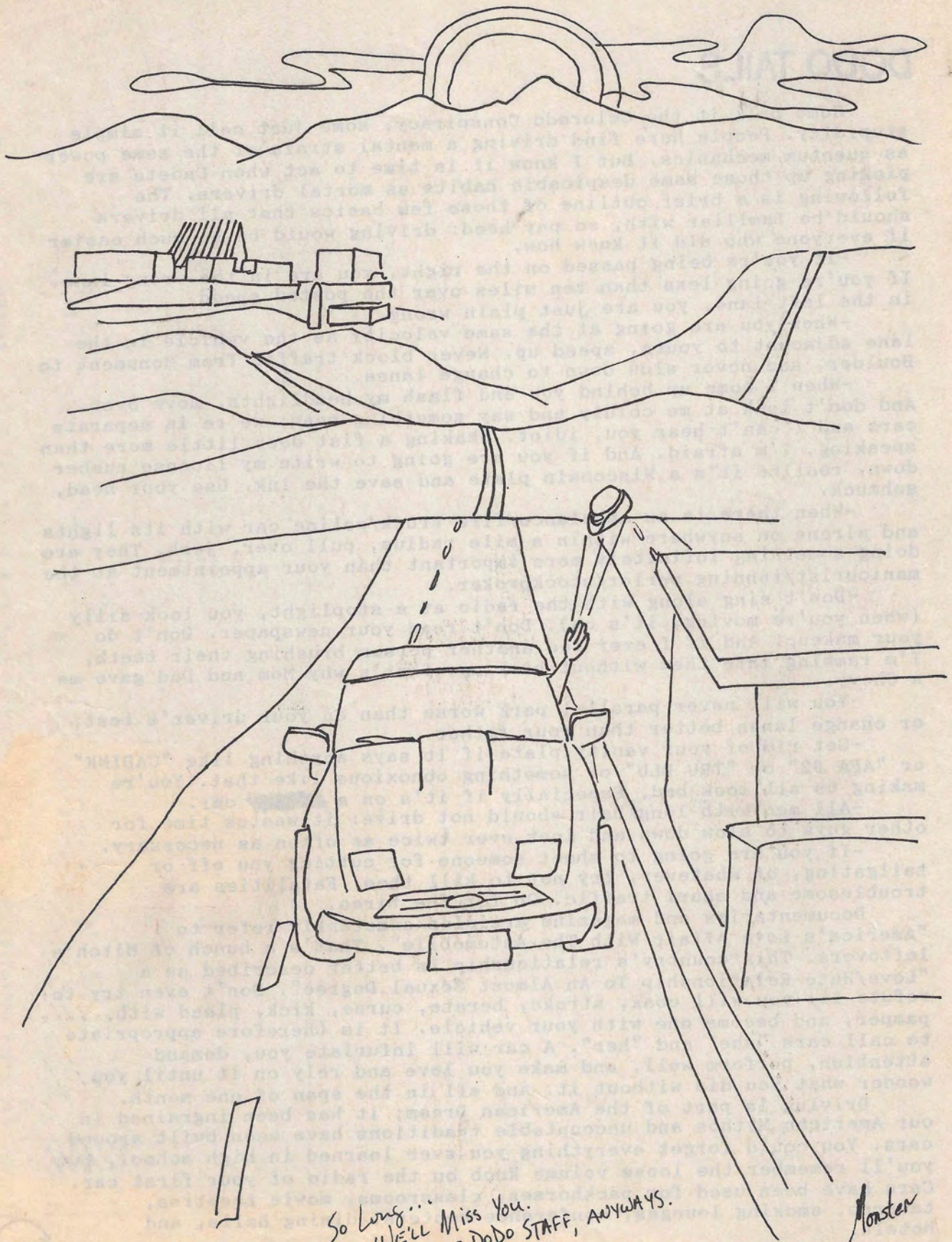
